#### **CHILDREN OF ACHIEVEMENT**

A bumper edition today, it's fantastic to see so many of our children doing so well outside of school! Well done, everyone at Winton Primary School is super proud of you all.

#### PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT (COMMONLY KNOWN AS FREE SCHOOL MEALS)

Has your family recently experienced a change in circumstances? Do you have a child in Year 2 about to move to Year 3 and will therefore no longer be eligible to receive a free school meal? Have you simply never got around to applying before?

Please see the criteria below and if you think you may qualify, we actively encourage you to apply. If your child is eligible, the school will receive funds which are used to improve the quality of education and

provision for children in school. The benefits to you are that you can receive a free hot meal each day for your child if you choose to do so, you are entitled to £40 to spend on uniform each year and you will receive reduced costs for residential visits. If you think you may be eligible please do register – there is no stigma attached and your child will not be identified in any way. Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit. You must also have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018, your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

#### Free school meals during Universal Credit roll-out

If you have any children who were deemed eligible as of 1st April 2018, their eligibility will be protected until 31st March 2023. This protection applies to the individual child only rather than the family.

All children who currently receive free school meals will remain eligible until 31st March 2023. This also applies to any new children who are approved.

This means between now and 31st March 2023, you do not need to contact us to cancel free school meals, even if you feel your child is no longer eligible.

From 31st March 2023, any child receiving free school meals will remain eligible until they have finished that school phase, for example, a child in reception on 31st March 2023 would remain eligible until they finish primary school in 2029.

# **Lunchtime Supervisor Assistant**

We need to increase our ability at lunchtimes to support children with their meals and to supervise them at play. We are now looking for a new lunchtime supervisory assistant to help us.

A lunchtime will cover 90 minutes of work between 11.45am and 1.15pm – daily, five days a week during term times.

We need someone who is friendly, approachable and good with children with a "can do" attitude; able to work under their own initiative. The role also includes maintaining a clean and hygienic area in which to eat food and the moving of chairs and tables, so cleaning and manual handling duties will be required. Our school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of our children. Rigorous checks will be made of the successful applicant's background and suitability to work with children, including a DBS check.

Within that organisation the school maintains many of the responsibilities that it had as a single academy, including school improvement and monitoring of the budget to ensure it is used to develop the school. 




