You can only attend if you have bought your ticket via ParentMail which are on sale until midnight on Sunday 4th December at £3.50 each. Physical tickets will not be issued, names will be checked against bookings at the start of each disco.

For the Reception and Year 1 discos, children should bring their disco clothes to school with them in a named bag, they will then get changed ahead of the disco and will be escorted there by staff, you do not need to collect them from the classroom after school

All other years should enter via the front door at the main entrance when arriving for their disco. Children who attend St Claire's on their disco days will be dropped off/collected as required. If they are going to the disco from St Claire's, please send them to school with their disco clothes and you must advise St Claire's that they are attending.

At the end of the disco, children are to be collected from the back of the hall, entering via the middle car-park courtyard gates.

Children can bring with them money to buy disco treats and toys (see list). We recommend no more than £3 per child and ideally if you can provide their money in 10p, 20p and 50p denominations it will be helpful.

If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or going to St Claire's, please ensure their money comes to school in a named purse/wallet and is handed to their teacher in the morning. The teacher will return the purse/wallet at the end of the school day.

YEAR 6 – UPDATED KS2 SATS TEST DATES
