BIG WALK AND WHEEL UPDATE

This was the first week of the Big Walk and Wheel competition and we are pleased to announce that we are currently in 1st place on the Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole leader board for recording the greatest number of active journeys.

The Year 6 active travel leaders have been busy each day checking classes are recording the data on the WOW tracker, as well as choosing bikes and scooters at random to win a prize for the golden lock.

There have been around 25 bikes being ridden to school each day and around 100 scooters. To ensure there is sufficient space for the bikes to be stored in the bike shelter, please can all children scooting to school try and leave their scooters in the blue scooter pods.
