At the time of publication, it's looking like it could be very good news indeed for Winton Primary! We are currently in first place across the BCP area with the highest percentage of active journeys being taken by our pupils. We will confirm the final results after the holidays.

- **446 children** have earned their March WOW tracker badge for recording at least 3 active journeys throughout the month.
- Bike mechanics from Sustrans came in and safety checked and repaired over **50 bikes**.
