Below this is the *Optional Donation* section where you can add an amount on top of the 1p (so if you would like to donate £5, you would type 4.99 in this field). You can make as many donations via this payment item as you like before the 9<sup>th</sup> June deadline.

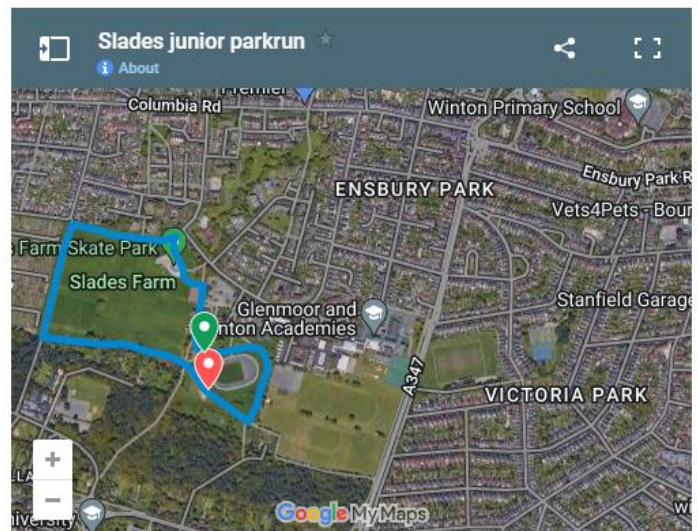

Slades Junior Parkrun is a free, fun, and friendly weekly 2km event for juniors (4 to 14 years old). The event takes place at Slades Park, Ensbury Avenue, Bournemouth, BH10 4HG.

Warm up starts at 8.50am. No one is ever last at parkrun so you can run, skip or walk across the finish line in your own time (we have a tail walker at the back to make sure everyone is safe).

Whilst the focus will be on the 2km run, there will of course be cake (it is a party after all!) and lots of other exciting things going on to help us celebrate our milestone event.
