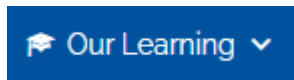

### HOW TO MAKE A DONATION VIA PARENTMAIL

Login in to your ParentMail account and go to Payments – Shop. Here you will see a Payment Item called **Fun Run 2023**. When you click into this item, the default payment amount is 1p. Below this is the **Optional Donation** section where you can add an amount on top of the 1p (so if you would like to donate £5, you would type 4.99 in this field). You can make as many donations via this payment item as you like before the 9<sup>th</sup> June deadline.

This week, alongside the newsletter, you have been sent the topic information sheet for the final half term for your child/ren’s year group/s. The current topic and curriculum information for each year group is always available via the Our Learning section of our website, where you will also discover lots more information and links to useful websites related to your children’s learning.
