Helping your child succeed at school

HOW TO MAKE A DONATION VIA PARENTMAIL

Login in to your ParentMail account and go to Payments – Shop. Here you will see a Payment Item called **Fun Run 2023**. When you click into this item, the default payment amount is 1p. Below this is the Optional Donation section where you can add an amount on top of the 1p (so if you would like to donate £5, you would type 4.99 in this field). You can make as many donations via this payment item as you like before the 9th June deadline.
