The day of the Summer Fayre - Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July, will be a mufti (non-uniform) day for the children.




Children can wear their own clothes for the day in exchange for donating the following items for the tombola at the fayre.

#### YEAR 6 LEAVERS' PERFORMANCE AND ASSEMBLY


