Bring a bottle, any bottle: alcohol, soft drink, bubble bath, toiletries, food etc. Anything in bottle form!

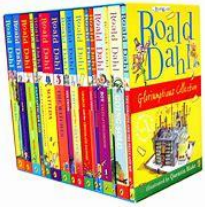


Just another reminder that the **Summer Raffle** tickets are available on ParentMail and can be purchased at £1 per ticket until midnight on Tuesday 11th July.
