Literacy



Comprehension

- Reading 'Lost and Found'
- Retelling 'Where is Spot?', 'Little Red Hen' and 'Oi Frog' using Talk4 Writing actions
- Learning the poem 'Autumn is Here'

Word Reading

- Decode words including Level 1+ sounds
- Read the level 1+ tricky and helpful words: the, to, no, go, I, into, little, ten, of



Writing

- Write CVC words (e.g. sat, pin) using the phonics sounds taught
- Forming letters using cursive handwriting



Communication and Language



Listening, Attention and Understanding

- Listen attentively to stories being read
- Ask questions about what they hear
- Join in with small group discussions

Speaking

- Offer own ideas in group discussion
- Use recently taught vocab - zig zag, factory, scar, grumpy, text, nervous, vanish, greedy, boiled, calm
- Begin to offer explanation why things might happen when playing e.g. with sand or water
- Express ideas and feelings about their experiences in full sentences

Mathematics



Number

- Composition of number 0-5
- Subitise amounts to 5
- Number Sense Maths

Number Patterns

- Counting verbally 0-10
- Compare quantities 0-5

Measure

- Sorting, matching and comparing objects
- 2D shapes - circle, triangle, square and rectangle
- Comparing size, mass and capacity using the vocab, longer, shorter and taller and equal and unequal

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Self-Regulation

- Show understanding of own feeling and those of others and regulate behaviour accordingly
- Learn to wait for what they want
- Give focused attentions to what the teacher says
- Follow instructions involving several ideas or actions



Managing Self

- Be confident to try new activities
- Show independence, resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge
- Know the classroom rules and how to treat others

Building Relationships

- Work and play cooperatively and take turns with others
- Form positive attachments to adults and friendships with peers

Physical Development

Gross Motor

- Negotiate space and obstacles safely
- Take part in paired and team games



Fine Motor

- Hold a pencil using a tripod grip
- Use cutlery to eat lunch



Expressive Art and Design



Creating with Materials

- Use pencils, pens, paint and chalk to draw themselves, their environment and familiar objects
- Join different materials using glue



Being Imaginative and Expressive

- Role Play Home including babies, toy food and celebration resources
- Sing nursery rhymes including, Twinkle Twinkle, Incy Wincy Spider and Wheels on the Bus
- Perform songs, rhymes, poems, stories and move in time to music

Past and Present

- Reading and learning about the lives and work of - Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King, Michelle Obama

People, Cultures and Communities

- Learning about celebrations, including who celebrates them, where they are celebrated and why they are important to different people - Diwali, Bonfire Night, Hanukkah and Christmas

The Natural World

- Looking for signs of autumn and winter and what these seasons look like in our outside environment
