To earn your badge, you need to share your love of books by answering a few questions. Maybe you could achieve the Book Badge? Visit the Blue Peter website to find out more:



Spotlight on... predictions



Each newsletter we will include some questions that you could ask your child, focussing on one area of reading comprehension.

<u>Predictions</u> can be made before you start reading as well as at key points during a story.

- X From the cover, what might this book be about?
- What is happening now? What happened before? What will happen next?
- > Do you think might happen? Why/why not?
- What is there in this paragraph that tells us what might happen next?
- X Can you justify your prediction with evidence from the text?
- **¾**Confirm and modify predictions in light of new information.
