Bookings for clubs for the Summer Term are now open via Arbor. Please refer to the [clubs newsletter](#) which was emailed to you on Wednesday 20th March for full details, instructions and links to the support guides.

PLEASE ONLY BOOK ONE CLUB PER CHILD DURING THE FIRST BOOKING WINDOW which closes on Wednesday 26th March. Additional bookings can be made when the bookings reopen at 8pm on Thursday 28th March.

The reason we operate a ‘one club only’ policy for the first booking period is to ensure that every child who wishes to attend a club can do so. If you book more than one club, we will delete all but one booking and we could remove your child’s preferred club. Please remember that if you book more than one club, you are taking the slot away from someone else’s child, so please do stick to the one club limit.

WHEN A CLUB IS FULLY BOOKED

If you have tried to book a club and after selecting the Term, you’ve then found the Membership Periods dropdown box empty on the next screen (see screenshot) and received the ‘The field is required’ error when trying to confirm registration, this means that the club is full. Places could still become available as we delete bookings for those who’ve booked more than one club. If you wish to go on the waiting list for a club, please email us after bookings close at 10pm on 16th April. **We will not accept waiting list applications until then.**

To see the clubs that your child is booked onto, you need to go to the Activities – Clubs section of your Arbor account.
