

Summer Term - Year 2

Reading



- * Recount - Titanic Trip
- * Story - Kassim and the Dragon
- * Whole Class Reading texts - 'Leon and the Place Between' and 'Kitty and the Tiger Treasure'.
- * Answer and ask questions about the text.
- * Make inference on the basis of what is being said and done.
- * Read Year 2 common exception words.

Writing



- * Recount - chronological order, first person, past tense, time connectives, add detail.
- * Story - story language, suffixes, adjectives, adverbs, subordination, coordination.
- * Use adjectives to add detail.
- * Use conjunctions - or, if, because, but, so.
- * Spell Year 2 common exception words.

Maths

- * Statistics - interpret and construct tally charts, pictograms and block graphs to represent and compare information.
- * Geometry - describe position, direction, movement and turns such as $\frac{1}{4}$ turn, $\frac{1}{2}$ turn, $\frac{3}{4}$ turn and whole turn.
- * Measure - length, height and temperature.
- * Addition and subtraction using two 2-digit numbers.
- * Multiplication and division - 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables.
- * Consolidate 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables.

- * Programming quizzes using Scratch Junior

PE



- * Athletics - sprinting techniques, jumping techniques and throwing underarm and overarm.
- * Games - develop tactics and lead when appropriate.

RE



- * What is the best way for a Buddhist to lead a good life? (Right speech)
- * Why do Christians believe God gave Jesus to the world?

Science



Summer 1

- * Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- * Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
- * Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

Summer 2

- * Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats.
- * Ask simple questions.
- * Observe closely, using simple equipment.

Music



- * Explore singing and clapping games from around the world.
- * Create and perform simple rhythmic and melodic accompaniments on percussion instruments.
- * Describe music using simple musical vocabulary.

PSHE



- * Dreams and Goals - Aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this.
- * Changing Me - Coping positively with change.
