MOBILE PHONES IN SCHOOL

Children in Year 5 and 6 who travel to or from school independently may bring their mobile phones to school. All phones brought into school must be switched off when the child is in the school grounds. They must then be into the collection boxes in their class as soon as they enter school. Phones are then stored in the office for the duration of the school day before being returned to the child as the bell goes.

Parents of children who bring their phone to school must sign a mobile phone agreement form which can be obtained by calling the school office who will send one to you electronically. By completing the form, you are agreeing to the conditions of your child bringing their phone to school.
