For the Reception and Year 1 discos, children should bring their disco clothes to school with them in a named bag. They will then get changed ahead of the disco starting and they will be escorted there by staff. You do not need to collect them from the classroom.

Children who attend St Claire's on their disco days will be dropped off/collected as required. If they are going to the disco from St Claire's, please send them to school with their disco clothes. Please advise St Claire's staff your child is attending a disco.

Children can also bring money to the discos for tuck items, more details of the items available will follow in a newsletter closer to the events. Please ensure all money is in a named purse.

### **DISCO BOOKING INSTRUCTIONS**

You will need to login to your Arbor account, go to the profile of the child that you are buying a ticket for and go to the School Shop. **The Year 3 & 4 disco is the only disco which can 'sell-out' (there is a limit of 150 children) so if you are purchasing a ticket for this disco, you may want to buy that one first!** If the disco does sell out, please speak to the office who can place your child's name on our waiting list.
