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TERM TIME HOLIDAYS

Like schools across the country, this year we have seen a marked increase in pupils who have a term-time holiday. I appreciate your honesty in the process of notifying us and accepting that this may lead to a fixed penalty notice. As you know the school gets no benefit from the fine and we try and do all we can to ensure fairness and equality in the process. As a school we monitor attendance closely and discuss any concerns directly with you, so if we are concerned about the impact of an absence we will discuss that with you. As you may have seen in the news there are proposals to change the process going forwards that are worth highlighting as you may be planning for next year.

The government are proposing to increase the cost of a penalty notice from £60 (per parent, per child, if paid promptly) to £80. If the proposal goes ahead, which seems likely, this will come into effect in September. The change also proposes a three year period where any further holiday would lead to a fine of £160 per parent, per child. A third holiday would not lead to a fine and it is more likely to lead to a parenting order or prosecution. At this stage it seemed important to make you aware of the proposed changes so that you can consider them when planning for the future.

Tickets for the discos will go on sale at 7pm on Friday 14th June via Arbor and will cost £3.50 each (which includes unlimited squash to drink). The deadline for buying tickets is midnight on Sunday 30th June.

For the Reception and Year 1 discos, children should bring their disco clothes to school with them in a named bag. They will then get changed ahead of the disco starting and they will be escorted there by staff. You do not need to collect them from the classroom.

Children who attend St Claire's on their disco days will be dropped off/collected as required. If they are going to the disco from St Claire's, please send them to school with their disco clothes. Please advise St Claire's staff your child is attending a disco.

Children can also bring money to the discos for tuck items, more details of the items available will follow in a newsletter closer to the events. Please ensure all money is in a named purse.
