We are delighted to announce that this year we have again achieved the School Games Platinum Mark award, which is the highest award you can get! The School Games Mark is a government-led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.



A couple of our favourite sporting achievements this year include:

- Increasing the percentage of children who get to compete in level 3 competition (against other schools) to over 50% in Year 5/6
- Winning a range of sporting competitions and leagues such as football, dodgeball, athletics and golf and setting some new town records in running events.

With a huge number of young people competing in local inter-school competitions this year, we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including those young volunteers, leaders and officials who made our competitions possible. As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year.
