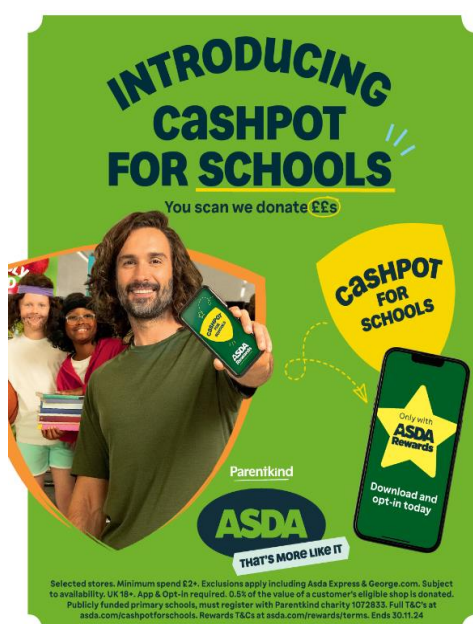
CHILDREN OF ACHIEVEMENT – IT’S A BUMPER BATCH THIS WEEK!

PFA INFORMATION

This is a further reminder of the fantastic ‘Cashpot for Schools’ initiative set up by Asda and Parentkind. Thanks to this scheme we have already raised an amazing £361.67 this term! However, I’m sure there’s many more of you who shop at Asda, or who have family and friends who do, who haven’t yet registered. If this is you, please do take the few minutes it takes to register and help our fundraising pot grow even larger!
