## FLU IMMUNISATIONS

Please refer to the email you were sent on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October for full details. The Dorset School Age Immunisations Service (DSAIS) are coming into school on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> October to administer this year's nasal flu vaccine to all year groups.

If you wish for your child to receive their vaccine, you need to complete the online consent form by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October: <https://links.inhealthcare.co.uk/dorset-flu> using the School Code: **7bmmdp**

If you do not wish for your child to receive the vaccine or they are receiving their vaccine elsewhere, please complete the form to say so. This helps reduce the time it takes the DSIAIS and the school to chase any missing responses.
