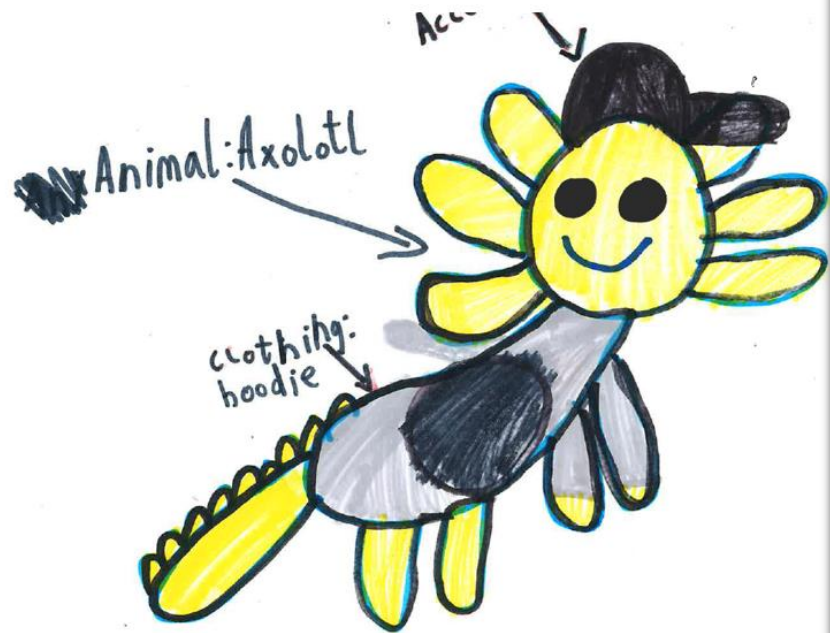


HOUSE COMPETITION – HOUSE MASCOT DESIGN WINNERS!

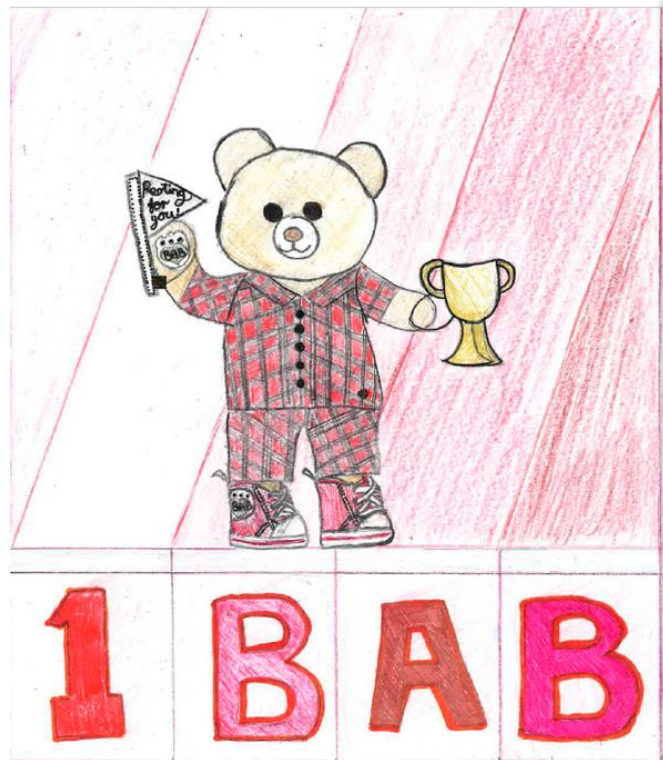

PFA INFORMATION

As revealed in last week's newsletter, the PFA are pleased to announce we will be holding 2 evenings of Winter Discos! We have booked the ever popular Liam from [OUTALIMITS](#) to DJ so we know the kids will have a great time.

Tickets will go on sale from tonight at 8pm via Arbor and will remain at the cost of £3.50 each (which includes unlimited squash to drink).

For the Reception and Year 1 discos, children should bring their disco clothes to school with them in a named bag. They will get changed ahead of the disco starting and will be escorted there by staff. You do not need to collect them from the classroom.

Children who attend St Claire's on their disco days will be dropped off/collected as required. If they are going to the disco from St Claire's, please send them to school with their disco clothes. Please advise St Claire's staff if your child is attending a disco.

Children can also bring money to their discos for tuck items. More details of what will be available to purchase will follow in a newsletter closer to the time. Please ensure all monies are in a named purse.



DISCO BOOKING INSTRUCTIONS

Please log into Arbor and go to the School Shop and look for PFA Winter Disco.

The combined discos are the only discos which could potentially sell out however by combining two disco slots we are hoping this will not be the case. However if you have children in Years 4, 5 and 6, we recommend getting in quick to secure your ticket! Years 4 & 6 will have a limit of 100 tickets and Year 5 should only purchase a ticket for one of the nights on offer; they cannot attend both. There will be a limit of 50 Year 5 tickets for each disco.
