The classes that won the extra playtime were: 1HT (£18.19), 3JE (£14.02) and 5SK (£13.45)! Well done!

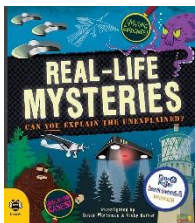
You can keep collecting any spare change and adding it to your Change4Change bottle as we will be adding the contents to our whole school total at the end of every half term!
