Reading


- * Whole class reading texts 'Dogger' and 'Little Polar Bear'
- * Reading and learning short poems including 'Five Little Owls', 'Mud' and 'First and Last'
- * Reading the Year 1 high frequency and common exception words (these can be found in your child's diary).



Writing

- * Write words including the Level 5 taught sounds as well as the tricky and helpful words.
- * Write a non-chronological report based on an imaginary creature.
- * Write a story based on an imaginary creature 
- * Retell and write the Talking Text 'The Train Ride'
- * Use s or es when writing plurals
- * Use the prefix 'un' e.g. unhappy, unwell.
- * Use conjunctions such as but and so and write list sentences.

Maths

- * Place value within 20 and then 50
- * Addition and subtraction within 20
- * Length and height [for example: long/short, longer/shorter, tall/short, double/half] 
- * Mass [for example: heavy/light, heavier than, lighter than]
- * Volume [for example: full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter]

Computing

- * Create media using tools such as; add, remove and change text

- * Different ways of travelling, moving and balancing in gymnastics
- * Invasion games

- * Dreams and Goals
- * Healthy Me

- * Exploring beat and rhythm
- * Listening and responding to music inspired by the theme of animals
