Northbourne Maintenance Works

We are writing to update you about upcoming maintenance works in Northbourne, which will consist of one kilometre of road resurfacing on the A341 Wimborne Road between Ferncroft Road and Northbourne roundabout. Work will commence on 4th July and is anticipated to last

until 18th July. To facilitate safe working, Wimborne Road will be closed to vehicular traffic in both directions between East Howe Lane and Northbourne roundabout. This closure will be in place for 24 hours each day during this period.

The following junctions with Wimborne Road will also be closed between 4th and 18th July - residents will need to use alternative exits from these roads during this time, where they are available:

- Ferncroft Road
- Ashridge Avenue
- Pinewood Avenue
- Avebury Avenue
- Northbourne Avenue
- New Road / Old Vicarage Close
- Gracie Mews

Please note that this is not a standard resurfacing scheme. The works involve deep excavation and recycling of the existing road base to improve the long-term durability and performance of the carriageway. This process is more intensive and will result in greater disruption than a typical 2 resurfacing project. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the footway; however it is advised that pedestrians use the footway on the southern side of Wimborne Road and use the dedicated crossing points when they need to access properties on the northern side of Wimborne Road. Cyclists may on occasion need to dismount and use the footway.

The following diversion routes will be in place during the closure period.

For vehicles wishing to travel eastbound, the diversion will reroute vehicles south at Bear Cross roundabout along Ringwood Road, east along Wallisdown Road, and then north up Boundary Road, Redhill Avenue and Whitelegg Way.

For vehicles wishing to travel westbound, the diversion will reroute vehicles east at Northbourne roundabout along Whitelegg Way, south at Redhill roundabout along Redhill Avenue and Boundary Road, west along Wallisdown Road and north along Ringwood Road, with vehicles being directed onto Wimborne Road at Bear Cross roundabout.
