Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to be offering you a grand total of **forty** extra-curricular clubs in the Spring term for children in Years 1 to 6! Please see below for the full list.

YOU WILL NEED TO USE YOUR ARBOR ACCOUNT TO SIGN-UP FOR SCHOOL RUN CLUBS

PLEASE READ THROUGH ALL OF THE INFORMATION BELOW PRIOR TO MAKING A BOOKING

YOU MUST ONLY BOOK ONE CLUB PER CHILD IN THE FIRST BOOKING WINDOW. IF YOU BOOK MORE THAN ONE, ALL BOOKINGS WILL BE DELETED AND YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO MAKE ANY BOOKINGS UNTIL THE SECOND ROUND. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS.

Please note that children who are already booked into Tuesday morning Production Club may still make one booking in the first booking window.

The clubs in pink are the paid for clubs which you need to book directly with the providers (details of these and how to make your enquiries/bookings are listed at the end of this newsletter). The blue clubs are the free, school-run clubs.

BOOKINGS PROCESS

One school-run club per child will be available to book from **8pm on Monday 8th December until 8am on Friday 12th December.**

You must only make one booking at this time

This makes the process fair and gives all the children that wish to, the chance to attend a club.

Please do not book more than one club as not only does this take a space away from someone else, it will also result in you losing all your bookings and you will not be able to make any club bookings until the second booking window opens. If you accidentally book more than one club in the first window, please notify the office via email immediately. If you do not do this, all of your bookings will be cancelled.

The second booking window will open at **8pm on Monday 15th December until 8am on Wednesday 7th January** and you can book any remaining spaces during this window.

- All clubs will start week commencing Monday 12th January with the exception of Shizenryu Karate club which starts on Friday 9th January.
- School run clubs will finish the week beginning 9th March. External clubs will finish week commencing 16th March with the exception of Karate which will finish on 27th March.
- School run clubs will not run the week commencing 2nd March due to Books at Bedtime.
- All clubs run straight after school until 4.20pm unless otherwise stated and all morning clubs start at 7.45am.

Before you scroll down to the list of available clubs and instructions on how to book, please read the notes below.

We know there is a lot to read, but it is really important that you do so!

To make a booking, login to your Arbor account and go to Activities and Clubs. **TOP TIP – If you are booking for more than one child, it is preferable to log on to the Parent Portal (via a website browser, on any device) rather than using the App at <https://winton-primary-school.uk.arbor.sc/>**

If a club is full, you will not receive a message telling you that it is full, it will simply not allow you to select the membership period. You will know that you have successfully booked the place when you get to the Consent screen and provide consent.

The booking system opens at 8pm on Monday 8th December and will remain open until 8am on Friday 12th December. During this first booking window, you must only book one club per child. If more than one booking is made, all bookings will be deleted, and you will not be able to make any bookings until the second booking window opens.

The booking window will re-open at 8pm on Monday 15th December to allow any remaining places to be booked and will remain open until 8am on Wednesday 7th January.

After both booking windows have closed, all school run clubs enquiries should be made via the office.

If your child missed out on a place in a club and you wish to add them to a waiting list, please email office@wintonprimary.uk but only after bookings have closed on 7th January. All waiting list enquiries made before this date will not be counted.

Children will be released to known adults at the end of their club or they will be collected by St Claire's if you have booked them a childcare space. If you have any concerns or specific instructions around this, please email office@wintonprimary.uk

Only children in Year 5 and 6 can leave their club without an adult collecting. If you wish for your child to walk home from their club, please go to the Consents section of your Arbor account (accessed via the View Student Profile section) and select 'After School Club Walk Home Consent' and grant consent. If a child in Year 5 or 6 has After School Club Walk Home Consent and tells the club leader they are walking home, they will be allowed to do so.

If you book your child onto a club, it is expected that they will attend regularly. Staff give up their free time to run these clubs for the benefit of the children and hope to see commitment and enthusiasm for the activity they're enrolled in. If your child misses three sessions without notifying the school office, they may be removed from the club.

Please be advised that after school clubs are not intended to be used as childcare. We cannot guarantee that clubs will run every week, and they may be cancelled at short notice for staff absence or for other events such as Parent Consultations.

If your child is not attending a club for any reason, you must notify the school office in the morning, please don't tell the teachers! You can call 01202 513988 or email office@wintonprimary.uk). We have up to 300 children attending clubs on some afternoons and looking for 'missing' children takes up a lot of time and our concern is that should there be a genuinely missing child, we may not be able to raise the alarm immediately as we are busy looking for children who have been collected at the end of the school day.
