Before booking your appointments, please read through the following carefully:

- Appointments will be face-to-face appointments at school.
- Appointments will be 10 minutes long.
- If you have more than one child at school, please leave at least 10 minutes between the end of one appointment and the start of the next appointment (eg Joe Bloggs at 4.00pm and Jane Bloggs at 4.20pm) to allow you time to get to the next classroom and to allow the schedule to run to time.
- All appointments need to be booked through Arbor.
- Parents with parental responsibility for whom we hold details on record, will be able to book appointments.
- **Please note that there is only one bookable appointment per child for these two dates.**
- If separated parents are not able to attend the same appointment, the parent who has not booked the appointment can contact office@wintonprimary.uk to request an appointment with their child's teacher at another time. This could be an in person meeting, telephone call or a Microsoft Teams meeting.
- Each meeting will last 10 minutes, should you still have matters you wish to discuss once the call is over, please contact the school via office@wintonprimary.uk and request that the teacher gives you a phone call.
