Text 07312 263131 for confidential advice and support from a member of the school nursing team.

Parents and carers can get advice regarding a range of concerns for their children, including toileting, sleep, development, behaviour, healthy eating and mental health.

The 5-19 ParentLine service is staffed from 9am-4pm, Monday to Friday (excluding weekends, bank holidays and school holidays), with a member of the School Nursing team responding to messages within one working day.

If you text outside of these hours, you will receive an automated message with advice on where to get help if you need it urgently. ParentLine is not an emergency service, for urgent medical attention contact your GP, 111 or 999.
