During the event, children will spend 30 minutes running the course around the school, and this year we're adding an extra element of fun by asking the children to run in fancy dress! Children are invited to dress up as superheroes or inspiring figures they admire, and they can wear these outfits for the whole school day.

We are also welcoming parents, carers, family members and friends to join in by running alongside the children. After last year's fantastic effort, we know how much of a difference this makes — every adult runner helps earn extra house points for the children's house teams! If running isn't for you, you're very welcome to cheer and support from the sidelines and enjoy the fun and excitement.

The Reception Fun Run will take place on Tuesday 19th May at 2.15pm. The children are encouraged to wear superhero or inspiring figures costumes into school on that day. Parents and carers are welcome to come and watch and support — **please enter the field via the top gate**, in Oswald Close near the staff car park/fire station.

It's a wonderful chance to have fun, stay active, and raise money for a great cause all at the same time. 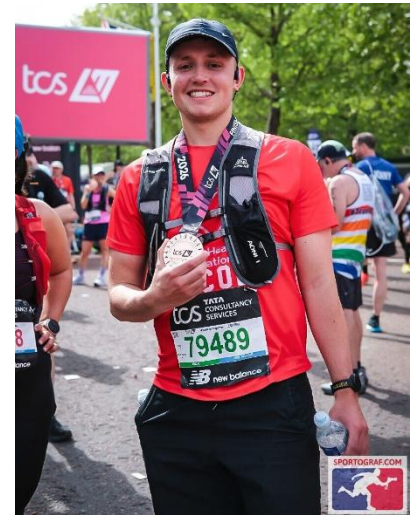

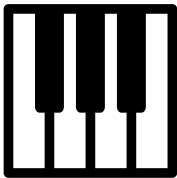
STAFF AND CHILDREN OF ACHIEVEMENT

IMPORTANT REMINDER – NUT-FREE SCHOOL

We must remind parents and carers that we are a strictly **NUT-FREE** school. This includes all nuts, not just peanuts. We have a number of children in school with life-threatening nut allergies. Even small traces of nuts can cause a serious medical emergency.

Unfortunately, we are seeing an increasing number of lunchboxes coming into school containing items with nuts or nut products. This is not acceptable and puts children's lives at risk.

Please check all food labels carefully before sending packed lunches and snack items into school. Many items contain nuts, including some that may not be obvious. Nutella and other chocolate or nut-based spreads contain nuts and must not be brought into school.

We ask all parents and carers to take this responsibility seriously and support us in keeping every child safe. Your cooperation is essential.

A full list of raffle prizes will be released in the next couple of weeks along with details of how to buy your tickets.



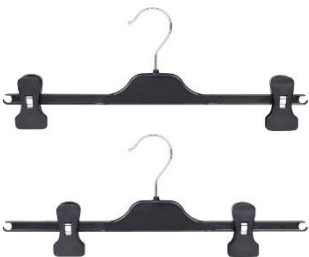
