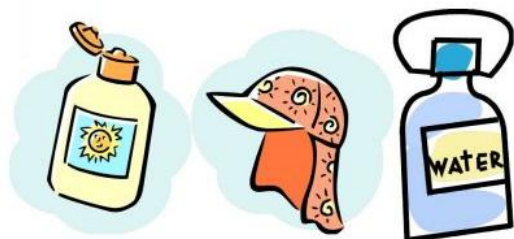

Don't forget to put the Summer Fayre date in your calendars! It's the event of the year! We hope everyone can join us outside straight after school.

A reminder it is a **NON-UNIFORM DAY** for the children, so they can wear their own clothes in exchange for donations for the tombolas. Please see to the right the items required, per year group. These should be bought in to school by the children on the day of the fayre.

TOKENS FOR GAMES STALLS AT THE FAYRE

We will again be using tokens for **ALL** game stalls at the fayre.

Tokens minimise the time needed to give out change when paying for a game which reduces queues.

Tokens will be available to purchase on the day, but to keep queues to a minimum, we recommend buying in advance by placing your order on Arbor. A token will cost 50p each, and each game will be either 1 or 2 tokens.



All games stalls will be token only. Refreshment stands, including the BBQ, the bar and the candy floss stall will be either cash or QR code.

All external stall holders, including the inflatables & rides, and the ice-cream van, will be cash although some *may* take card. **THEY WILL NOT ACCEPT TOKENS.**

Buying tokens in advance is highly recommended and this is what makes the system work! If you end up waiting until the day, you will end up spending your time at the fayre queuing up to buy tokens!

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO BUY TOKENS IN ADVANCE

Tokens are available now to buy on Arbor - we are selling these in £5 bags (10 tokens). You may wish to buy more than 1 bag.

Please log into Arbor and go to the School Shop and look for PFA Fayre Tokens.

All orders will be delivered to the child's class on the day of the fayre, and they will come out of school with their tokens in a money bag ready to spend!

Tickets will be on Arbor until 10am on Monday 8th June (the same deadline as the raffle).

PLEASE NOTE: We will not be able to refund any tokens at the end of the fayre or after the fayre. We have over 20 games on offer so hopefully plenty of opportunities for everyone to spend all their tokens. But if you happen to have any leftover, then we suggest you could spend them at the book stall or the refreshments, candy floss or sweet stall before the end.

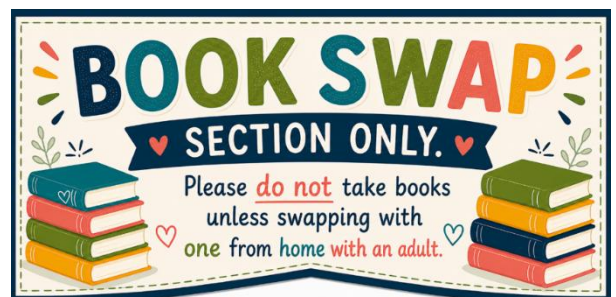
A book swap is a fun way to share stories. When you've finished reading a book at home, you can bring it in and swap it for a new one to enjoy!
