Is your child currently entitled to free school meals and in receipt of the pupil premium grant? **For this to continue next school year, you need to reapply** and your eligibility will be reassessed. **All children currently entitled to income based free school meals/pupil premium grant will stop being eligible from the end of the school year.**

To reapply – do so online at <https://www.bcpccouncil.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/support-with-education/free-school-meals> or complete and return a form you can collect from the school office. **If you want to order free meals for September**, it is vital that you **reapply now**.

If you are not currently eligible but your **household is on Universal Credit**, you will become eligible for free meals from September, but you **must apply**. Please see above for how to do this.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL PROVISION

Many of you may have seen recent reports that BCP Council is proposing to withdraw school crossing patrol officers at our school, along with others across the BCP area. It is understood that these crossings may be replaced with zebra crossings. This proposal has raised a number of concerns within the school and local community about the safety of children travelling to and from school.

Our local MP, Jessica Toale, has written to Millie Earl, Leader of BCP Council, urging her to reconsider this decision and The Bournemouth East MP, Tom Hayes (pictured above) has created an [online petition](#).
