As we approach the PFA Summer Fayre, on Friday 12th June, we're asking for your support. To help avoid long queues for our 840 pupils and families, please buy games tokens in advance via Arbor – the deadline is 10am on Monday.

We also urgently need volunteers – even a short time slot makes a big difference, and any family member can help. Without enough support, the fayre may not be able to go ahead, and future events could be affected.

The PFA plays a vital role in funding school improvements, so your help really matters. If you can volunteer, please email <mailto:pfa@wintonprimary.uk> as soon as possible.

Important: Changes to Free School Meals – Action Required

From September, the Government is changing how Free School Meals (FSM) are assessed. More families may now be eligible, but all current eligible families must reapply.

What you need to do:

- If your child currently receives Free School Meals, you **MUST** reapply before the end of this term.
- If you do not reapply, your child will not be able to receive free meals in September (Years 3–6).

All parents/carers were emailed on Monday 1st June — please read this as soon as possible if you haven't already.

Why applying is so important:

Applying is not just about free meals:

- It can give your child access to additional support, such as:
 - Uniform grant
 - Help with residential school trips
 - Holiday activities (HAF)
- It directly affects school funding

The school receives additional funding (Pupil Premium) for eligible pupils.

This funding helps provide extra resources, support and opportunities for all children.

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 (Universal Infant Free School Meals), or you do not plan to take the meals, you should still apply.

Who is eligible?

There are now two categories:

- **Targeted FSM**
 - Household on Universal Credit
 - Annual earnings under £7,400
 - Includes additional financial support and school funding
- **Expanded FSM**
 - Household on Universal Credit
 - Earnings over £7,400
 - Entitled to free meals only

How to apply:

- Apply online: <https://www.bcpCouncil.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/support-with-education/free-school-meals>
- Or request a paper form from the school office

Important timing: Due to high demand, applications may take several weeks to process by the FSM team at BCP Council.

Current FSM eligibility will continue until the end of this academic year, regardless of your new application outcome.

Tokens are needed for all games and can also be used for refreshments, including the candy floss and sweet

Ideally, we ask that you bring cash to the fayre.

Although we have the facility for QR payments for school run stalls, we are charged a percentage of each transaction, whereas every penny paid in cash will go into the fundraising pot*. Cash will be needed for refreshments, any extra raffle tickets and tokens, as well as for purchases from external stallholders.

It is going to be a busy fayre! We have approximately 20 external stallholders attending, with offerings ranging from jewellery, sourdough, pocket money toys, brownies & treats, travel information, face painting and pottery to name but a few! The external stallholders take their own methods of payment and DO NOT accept Tokens; this also includes the inflatables & children's ride.

*Remember, all funds raised from the fayre and raffle are paying towards the water filling stations.

If anyone would like to help selling on the refreshments at the fayre and hasn't already made contact, please email us pfa@wintonprimary.uk. We are low on helpers during the fayre so it would be much appreciated - you could even send aunties, uncles or grandparents to help!

SCHOOL COUNCIL UPDATE
